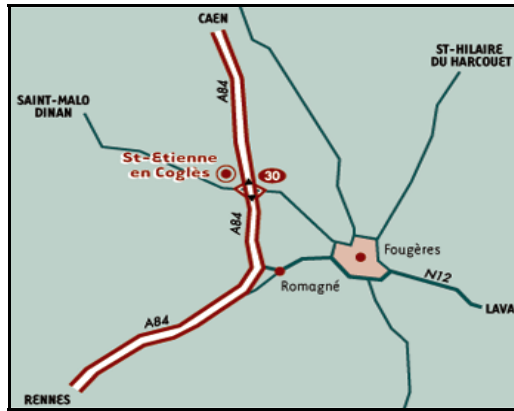
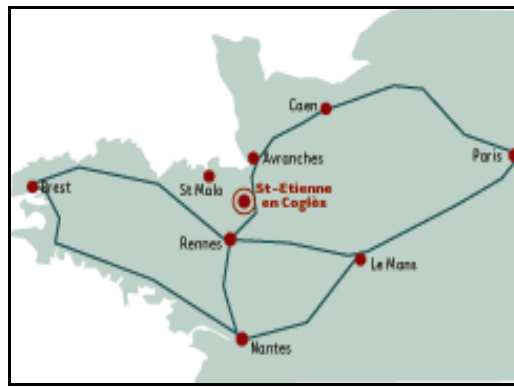

Sandy beaches, secluded coves and pretty coastal villages with delicious seafood restaurants are also within easy reach as are the popular resorts of St Malo, Cancale and Granville.

Head in-land for Rennes, the capital of the region to find a historic city centre, large market and plenty of shopping opportunities, or enter the enchanted forest of Brocéliande - with its Arthurian myths and legends.
